# Advancing UHC and Pandemic Preparedness, and Ending Tuberculosis

## Strategies to Foster Innovation and Support Greater Access

Amid the current global health crisis, there is a growing urgency on the discussion around **Universal Health Coverage (UHC)**, and **pandemic prevention, preparedness, and response (PPR)**, and **ending the tuberculosis (TB) epidemic**.

As member states discuss the zero drafts of the UHC, PPR, and TB declarations and resolutions ahead of endorsement by heads of state at the UN High-Level Meetings in September 2023, a crucial question remains: How can we foster a **sustainable and thriving innovation ecosystem for healthcare** that supports Universal Health Coverage and better pandemic preparedness, and help end tuberculosis?

This question lies at the heart of our event hosted with Foreign Policy on 8 May 2023 in New York. The conversation will explore the critical **role of innovation**, and how public and private actors can share efforts and **work in partnership to strengthen health systems and improve access to medicines and vaccines**.
